It is my firm conviction that the Holy Spirit has called the ANCC into existence to be leaven in the bread for the Catholic Church, and has established us to join the Church in implementing the important ecclesial, pastoral, and liturgical reforms of the Second Vatican Council.

Your parish's informed decision in joining the ANCC in this mission adds your voice to ours in proclaiming to the world our belief that the central message of Jesus Christ, as manifested in the fullness of the doctrines and the sacramental life of the Catholic Church, is God's love for everyone, no exceptions.

- The American National Catholic Church joins the Church Catholic in her missionary and evangelical efforts to "Go out to all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

Thank you for your courage in joining with us, and know of our gratitude and prayers that God who has begun this good work in us will bring it to completion on the day of our salvation.
